
















I want to share with you where my mind has come to rest as I approach the end of my pilgrimage on earth and it is – God wants his people to **become like Christ**.

.....As Christ has entered our world, so we are to enter other people's worlds


















THE GOSPEL CHANGES



I hold a number of strong convictions:

- •There is no way to reevangelize this nation apart from the impact of the daily lives of ordinary, everyday Christians.
- •The ultimate test of the fruitfulness and authenticity of any church, irrespective of its style or tradition, is the quality of the disciples it makes.
