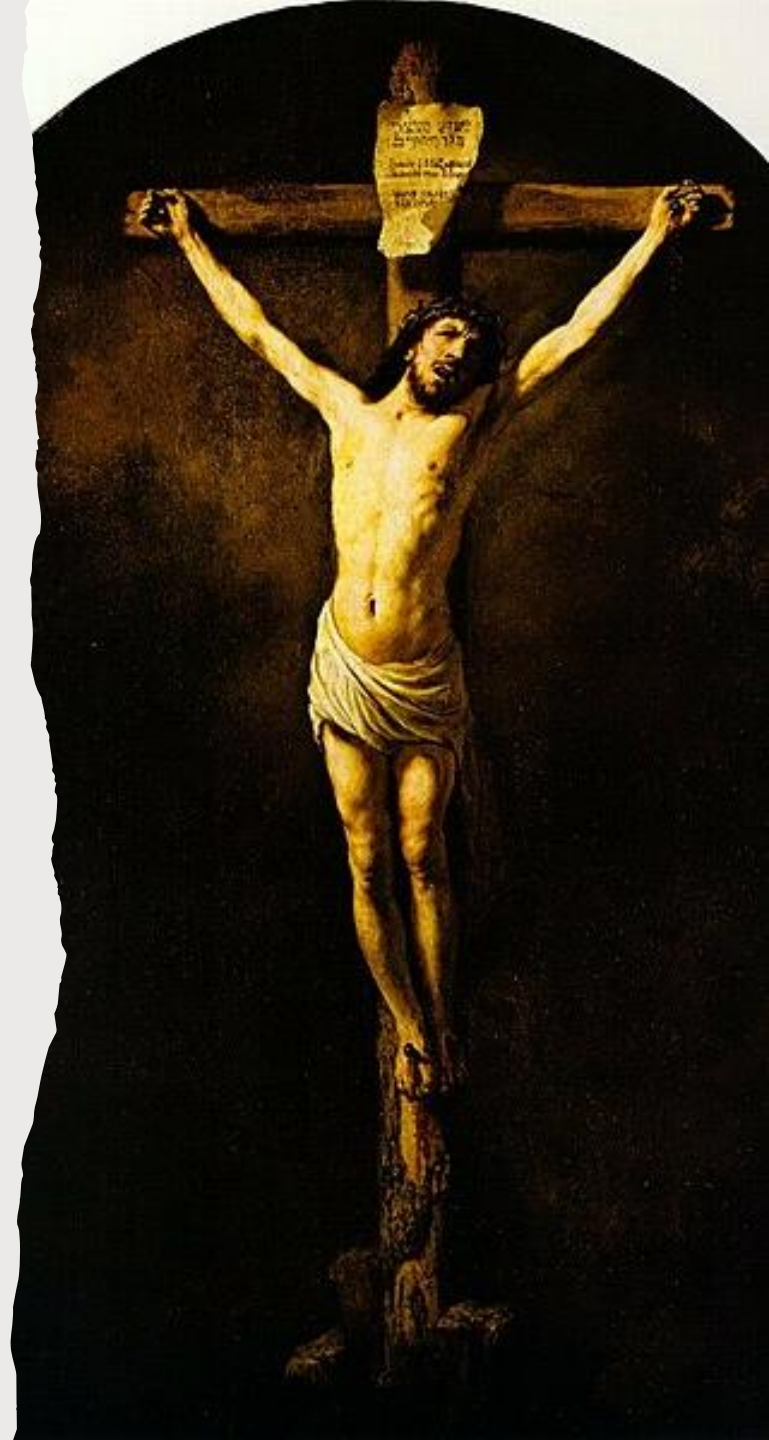






At få se - at få åbenbaret - hans herlighed

- Joh 1,14: vi så hans herlighed - fuld af nåde og sandhed





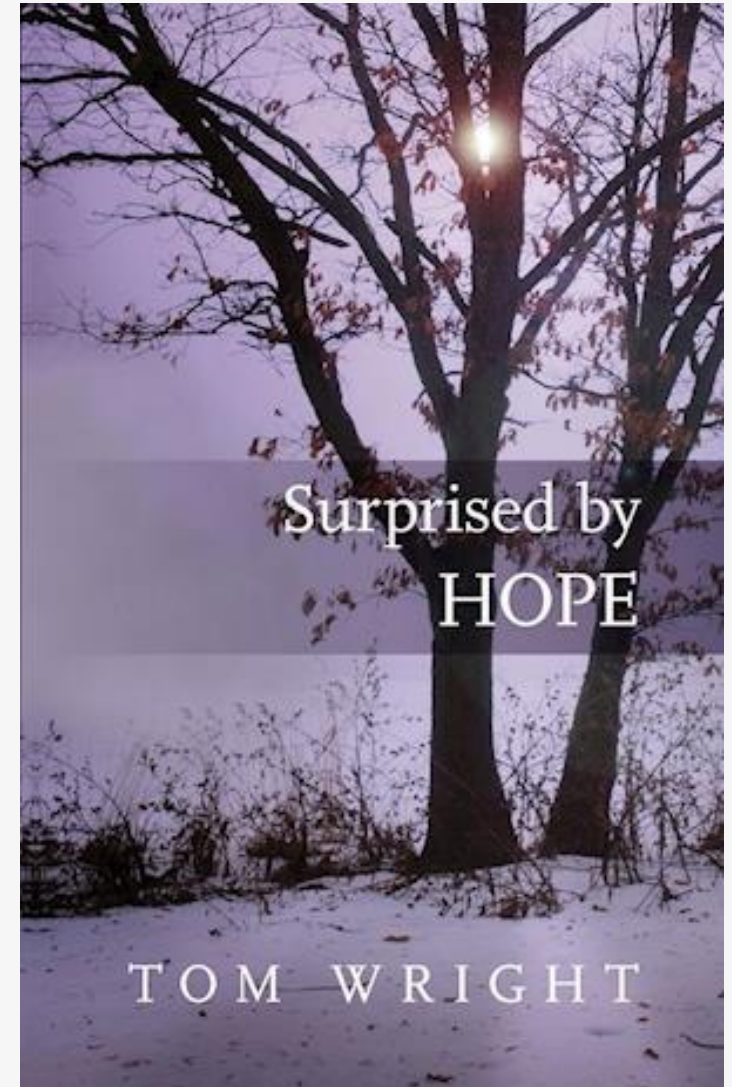

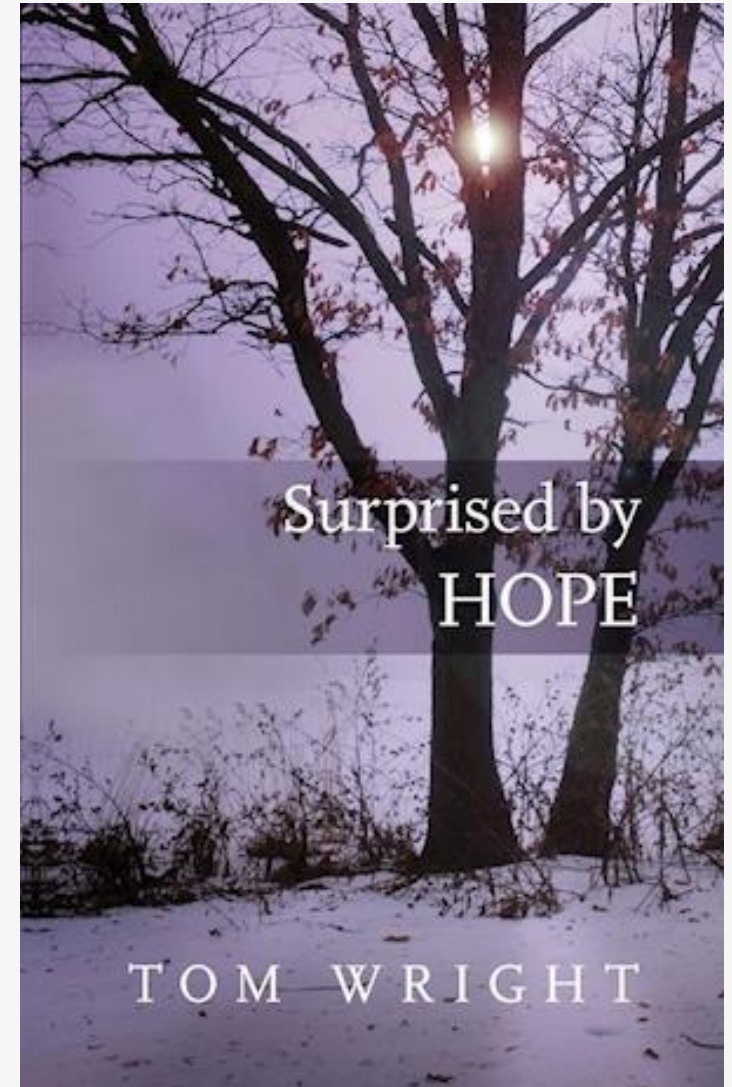
Tom Wright – Surprised by Hope

- The crucifixion of Jesus was the end of all their hopes.
- Nobody dreamed of saying: Oh, that is all right – he'll be back in a few days.
- Nor did anybody say, "well, at least he is now in heaven with God."
- They were not looking for that sort of Kingdom. After all Jesus had taught them to pray that God's kingdom would come on earth as in heaven.



Tom Wright – Surprised by Hope

- What they said was things like this.
- “We had hoped ... but they crucified him so he can't be” ...
- Crucifixion meant that the kingdom hadn't come; not that it had.
- Crucifixion of a would-be Messiah meant that he wasn't the messiah – not that he was.



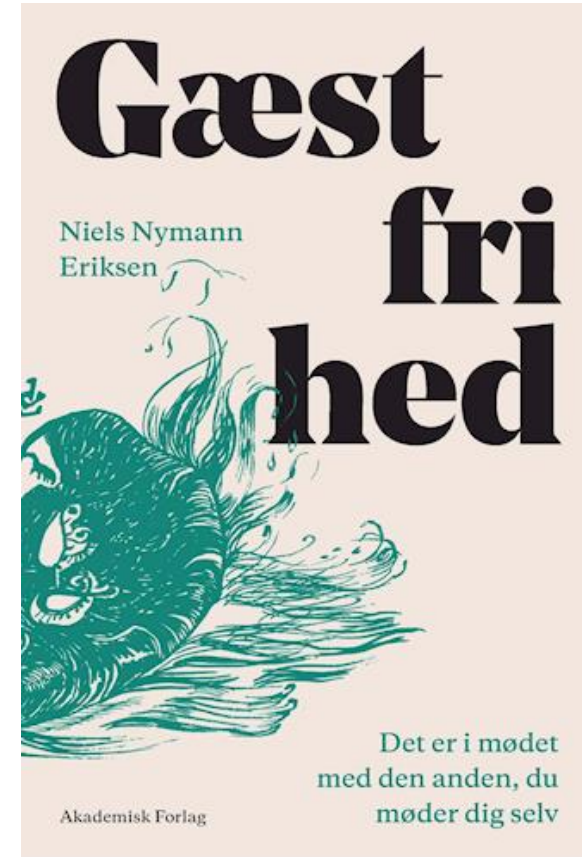
